We are very pleased with our Key Stage 2 SATS results in 2016. The number of children reaching the new, more challenging national expected standard was higher than the national average in all 3 key areas of reading, writing and maths. The figure of 66% of children reaching the national standard in all 3 areas combined is significantly about the national average. Well done year 6s!
