For children reaching the expected standard, we are well above the national averages in all areas and the headline figure of 80% of children reaching the expected standard in all 3 key areas combined is significantly above the national average. The progress our year 6s make from the end of Key Stage 1 (year 2) continues to be amazing. To help you appreciate these figures and compare us against other schools, these results mean that:

Reading: we are 'well above average' (Approximately top 6% of schools)
Writing: we are at the top end of 'average' (Approximately top 21% of schools)
Maths: we are 'above average' almost 'well above average' (Approximately top 11% of schools)
