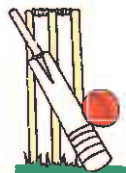

Dear Parent or Guardian,

EBC Inspire is the only operating kid's outdoor fitness boot camp in Essex, we come into schools and run sessions that will focus on team work, communication and we will work with the kids to ensure they are working to best of their ability.

Your son/Daughter school has recently secured Inspire for this term and we would really like to have as many pupils attend the club.

The club will be on Wednesday After school for KS2 3.15-4.15pm.

All your child will need is appropriate clothing that you don't mind being muddy and a bottle of water. (please note all sessions will be held outside regardless of weather)

Using different growth mind-set techniques, we will engage pupils to work as a team, work in different age groups and complete tasks leaving them with a positive attitude. All this will be achieved using different equipment such as cargo nets, tyres, poles, logs.....

If this is something you think your child could benefit from or you just want them to try something different other than your main stream sports, then please send them along.

This will cost £5.00 per session but we would ask that you pay for all the sessions upfront, we are going to be running 12 sessions this term. Starting Wednesday 18th April ending on Wednesday 11th July 2018.
